We work with them to develop strategic objectives to improve services to attract investment and human capital. Portraits of Prosperity

In 2022, over 50 youth from 18 schools and universities sent in submissions for CRECE's newest project to highlight entrepreneurship activity in Puerto Rico and its value to our communities through visual arts. At the San Juan photography exhibit, we hosted 800 visitors from across the island. 100% of participants and 97% of visitors said they now understand that entrepreneurship adds value to communities in Puerto Rico! In 2023, we will take the contest and learning showcase to Ponce and beyond.

Lemonade Day

People in Puerto Rico want the best for our children. We want them to grow up as self-starters and risk-takers who build their own paths to success. Lemonade Day creates opportunities for youth to plan and operate their own businesses and reap the rewards of hard work while also saving and sharing some of their profits. In the last four years, over 4,500 children and 1,500 parents and mentors have participated in Lemonade Day's unique learning experience. In 2023, we will offer our Lemonade Day program in public school classrooms, significantly expanding our reach by adding up to 3,000 more kids!

In June 2022, CRECE was honored to host former President of Argentina, Mauricio Macri, for an insightful conversation about the present dangers of populism and insider information on South America. Macri spoke eloquently about the need to promote markets, liberal societies, increase business opportunity, stamp out corruption, and build prosperity for families and communities. This is exactly what CRECE works to do, every day.

Policy Solutions Bringing Prosperity

Our Competitiveness Toolkit educates – and holds accountable – elected and appointed government officials and business leaders in factors that will make Puerto Rico more prosperous, increasing economic growth. The Toolkit includes data on starting a business, and the time required to obtain a construction permit that can be used to create more effective systems and procedures to foster free enterprise.

Meanwhile, the Economic Freedom Index is a data-driven, objective research project to analyze the level of economic freedom in Puerto Rico and compare it to other states. By sharing findings with lawmakers, educating the general public, and charting paths for policy reform, the index can be used to create data-based and drive positive change.
